Town of Algoma Safe Routes to School Resolution

Whereas, the health and safety of our children is of the highest concern to the citizens of the Town of Algoma and the Town Board; and

Whereas, a lack of physical activity plays a leading role in the rising rates of obesity, diabetes and other health problems among children; and

Whereas, being able to walk or bicycle to school along safe routes offers an opportunity to build healthful physical activity into a daily routine and arrive at school ready to learn; and

Whereas, Safe Routes to School programs are recognized nationally as effective tools to enable and encourage students to walk and bicycle safely to school; and

Whereas, having safer routes to and from schools aim to decrease pedestrian and bicycling related injuries, not just for children, but for the entire community; and

Whereas, Safe Routes to School can contribute to a positive connection between Oakwood Elementary students and our neighborhoods by creating beneficial interactions between the children and adults; now, therefore be it

Resolved, that the Town of Algoma Town Board hereby commends the Safe Routes to School program overseen by East Central Wisconsin Planning with support from the Oshkosh Area School District; and be it finally

Resolved, that the Town of Algoma Town Board will support the ideology of the Safe Routes to School initiative and will work alongside Oakwood Elementary School with their participation in the Safe Routes to School initiative, gaining the benefits mentioned above and strengthening the quality of life for the Town of Algoma community.


