Whether you're walking, biking, or riding, you're sharing the road with cars, buses, and other people. Here are some tips to do it safely:

Stay out of car's blind spots - if you can't see the driver, they can't see you!

Always ride your bike the same way the cars are going. Use the bike lane if there is one. If not, ride close to the edge of the road, away from traffic.



Never assume the driver sees you – always stop and look left, right, then left again before you cross the street. Try to wave or look at the driver to know they see you!



Stay on sidewalks if possible. If there's no sidewalk, walk facing traffic as close to the curb as possible.
